Subject: Input Request for Issuance of Recreation Special Use Permits on Sulphur Ranger District

Hello,

The Sulphur Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest is considering authorizing 2 special use permits for outfitting and guiding for side by side OHV use on system roads and trails. The special use authorization purposed involve the use of existing system roads and trails only. The OHV operations proposed are either currently taking place, or have taken place in the past. Operators being considered:

- 1) Grand Adventures, Outfitting and Guiding (OHV), up to 3,500 service days on Corona Road (FS 149).
- 2) Spirit Lake Motorsports, Outfitting and Guiding (OHV), up to 3,000 service days on the Stillwater Trail System.

The permits will be for terms up to 10 years. A map of the routes and areas used for these activities can be found at:
