Vasquez and Little Vasquez creeks are an important source of drinking water for the Town of Winter Park. Due to concerns about forest fires as well as water pollution, the area within a quarter-mile on either side of these creeks will be closed to visitors for dispersed camping for a year, per the USDA Forest Service.
