Prior to the Town scheduling the petition for possible Council acceptance, the petitioner(s) shall attend a regular Town Council meeting where the Town Council will determine the amount of a consultant cash deposit that may be requested by the Town to process the annexation request.

Consultants that may be retained by the Town could include, but are not limited to, the Town Attorney, planners, architects, civil engineers, wetlands experts, etc. Once the Town Council makes a determination that certain consultants need to be hired by the Town, a letter explaining the type of consultant and the amount of the required consultant deposit will be mailed to the property owner(s) and/or his agents for their review and acceptance.

Cash deposits will be placed in a separate Town banking account as the separate property of the Town and used by the Town Clerk to pay for consultant services and the petitioner(s) shall receive a monthly accounting which will document the cost of consultant services. Once the deposited amount is expended, the Town Council shall meet with the petitioner(s) and the Council shall determine the amount of an additional cash deposit. Any funds remaining after the annexation is approved or denied by the Council shall be returned to the petitioner(s).

In addition to the above requirements, the petitioner(s) may also be subject to Reimbursement Fees as outlined within Section 7-10-8 of the Town Code. Said Section specifically addresses incomplete applications associated with development projects.
