JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

The Transit Manager is responsible for implementing the transit programming elements of the Transit Department. This includes but is not limited to:

- Contractor auditing and oversight of operations.
- Manage 5311 funding and capital replacement grants.
- Oversight and facilitation of the Transit Advisory Committee. Provide resolution and memos regarding transit service to Town Council.
- Attend local and regional transit coordination meetings. Including NWTPR, RTCC, I-70 Coalition, and state grant partner meetings.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A minimum of three years of experience in municipal government or public/private transit operation required.
- Bachelor's degree in Transportation Management, Public Administration, Urban and Regional Planning or a related field required.
- General knowledge of contract compliance and transit grant management is desired.

- Salary of \$69,600 - \$104,520 plus excellent benefits.
- Medical, dental, vision, PTO, 401A and 457 options. Paid travel opportunities for conferences and capital procurement.




GET TO KNOW WINTER PARK

The Town of Winter Park, CO is an authentic, active mountain town in the central Rocky Mountains with around 1,000 full-time residents and many second homeowners. With the Winter Park Resort only two miles away from the downtown core, tourism is a major industry in the community. Town growth is also expected over the next few years with new development projects and a focus on affordable housing.

With over 600 miles of trails, 300 days of sunshine, and more than 300 inches of snow each year, it's no wonder Winter Park is known as "Colorado's Favorite Playground".
