Later this month, CDOT and contractor KSK, LLC will begin ADA Ramp improvements on US Highway 40 throughout downtown. The project will improve ramps, curbs, gutters and sidewalks located at several intersections.



Grand County Ranches and U.S. Forest Service Potential Land Exchange

Grand County Ranches and the United States Forest Services are considering a potential land exchange. The potential exchange would be approximately 1,536 acres of Grand County Ranches land for approximately 543 acres of United States Forest Service land. Both properties are located above 9,200 feet, within Grand County and in close proximity to the Towns of Winter Park and Fraser.

The exchange would follow the Forest Service multi-phase land exchange process including evaluation under the National Environmental Policy Act, preparation of environmental analysis, and public notice and comment before any decision is made to finalize the land exchange.
