

# Voter Instructions

Grand County General Election, November 3, 2020

## What is in my ballot packet?

- Your official ballot
- These voter instructions
- A secrecy sleeve
- An official return envelope

## Need a replacement ballot?

Call 970-725-3065 or visit any VSPC. The last day for the County Clerk's Office to mail you a replacement is October 26.

## How do I return my ballot?

- Drop it off at a county-controlled drop box
- Deliver it to a VSPC
- Mail it back



## Mailing Information

The US Postal Service (USPS) needs time to process and deliver your ballot. Therefore, we recommend personally delivering your ballot to any of the locations listed on this page. It is a violation of law to receive more than ten ballots for mailing or delivery in any election. All valid ballots are counted in the same manner, regardless of the closeness or outcome of any race.

If you do return your ballot through the USPS, you must affix adequate postage to your envelope.

## How do I vote my ballot?

Follow all of the voting instructions on your ballot: After you vote:

1. Refold your ballot
2. Place your ballot inside of the secrecy sleeve
3. Place the secrecy sleeve and ballot in the official return envelope
4. Sign and date the self-affirmation located on your own official return envelope. See the example below:

### Important:

- You must sign the affirmation on the envelope.
- Do not sign, initial, or print your name on the ballot.
- The official return envelope may only contain your ballot. If you include another voter's ballot in the same envelope, none of the ballots will count.

## Do I need to provide an ID?

No, the signature on your official return envelope will be used to verify your ID.

## How can I track my ballot?

You can go to [www.govotecolorado.gov](http://www.govotecolorado.gov) or call us at 970-725-3065 to confirm that we received your ballot.

The County Clerk's Office must receive your ballot by 7:00 PM on Election Day. Postmarks do not count.

Go to <https://colorado.ballottrax.net> and sign up for alerts when we receive, accept and count your ballot.
