Workforce Housing Moving Forward

Our goal is to provide plenty of attainable housing, which helps build a strong year-round economy. We're excited to be moving forward with two more options for the community.

Hideaway Junction House

A house within Hideaway Junction is available for purchase! The Town is accepting applications from interested, eligible buyers until Nov. 12 at 5 p.m. The available home at 108 Trestle Drive is a three-bedroom, two-bathroom unit with a two-car garage. The anticipated sale price of the home is \$286,000. The Town will complete the selection process on Nov. 20, at 3 p.m. [Apply Now](#)

Fireside Creek Apartment

Town Council recently approved an agreement with Winter Park Partners, LLC to develop the Fireside Creek complex that would bring 70 new workforce apartment units. Winter Park Partners will manage the complex and rent the apartments. However, the units will be deed-restricted so that only people who work in the area will be eligible to rent the units. A Short-Term Rental Advisory Panel was recently formed to develop policies and regulations around short-term rentals (STR) in our community.
