

GRAND COUNTY WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT #1

MONTHLY SERVICE FEES SCHEDULE

Effective November 1, 2021

Water and sewer customers are required to pay a monthly fee. The monthly fee consists of Readiness to Serve charge plus the use – (generation) charge for each water and sewer service.

- A. WATER – Readiness to Serve charge. This charge is set at \$21.00/SFE/month. In instances of larger water meters in a single family detached house with one kitchen use, number of SFE per building in multi family use, and a higher SFE rating for water meters in commercial use, the Readiness to Serve charge is computed by multiplying \$21.00 by the SFE rating. Additionally, the use of water is charged at a rate of \$1.05/1000 gallons for the first 4,000 gallons/SFE/month: 4000 to 8000 gallons of use is charged at the rate of \$1.35/1000gal/month; for amounts over 8000 gallons within a single monthly billing cycle, shall be charged to the customer at a rate of \$2.75 per thousand gallons of metered use.
- B. SEWER – The District has adopted a policy of basing sewer charges on water use according to the following schedule:

|               |                                  |
|---------------|----------------------------------|
| Single Family | = 70% of metered water use/month |
| Multi-Family  | = 75% of metered water use/month |
| Commercial    | = 80% of metered water use/month |
| Lodging       | = 85% of metered water use/month |
| Restaurants   | = 90% of metered water use/month |

Additionally, a Readiness to Serve Charge is payable at \$23.00/month/SFE. The generation of sewage charge is based on a rate of \$2.50/1000 gallons for the first 8000 gallons used, thereafter all additional use is charged at the rate of \$3.50 per 1000 gallons, adjusted according to the above table in order to account for the different strengths of sewage and, consequently, the different difficulty to treat the same.

Properties which have reserved taps will not start to pay a service fee until it is physically tapped into the main or connected to stub outs from the main.

Tap fees that are purchased for a piece of property will begin paying service fees immediately. These purchased tap(s) have one (1) year from date of purchase to be put into use. At the end of that one (1) years' time the tap(s) will be canceled, service fees will be discontinued, and a credit will be given for the amount the tap(s) were purchased for. The amount paid for service fees will not be refunded or credited. The amount of the tap fee will not be refunded. To purchase tap(s) at a later date it will be necessary to pay any difference between the credit and the current tap fee at the time.
