Pursuant to Presidential Executive Order 14074 (Section 12):
https://www.presidency.ucsb.edu/documents/executive-order-14074-advancing-effective-accountable-policing-and-criminal-justice which was signed by President Joe Biden on May 25, 2022, the Fraser Winter Park Police Department is required to make the following public notification.
"We are currently enrolled in the 1033 Program, which originated from the National Defense Authorization Act of Fiscal Year 1997. The Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) within the Department of Defense (DoD) oversees this program which allows transfer of excess DoD property that might otherwise not be utilized to law enforcement agencies. Locally, this program is administered by the Colorado State Patrol.

For potential acquisitions of property in this program we will be notifying our local civilian governing body yearly regarding any controlled property we may acquire. Some of the items we may request could include ammunition, armored and tactical vehicles, command and control vehicles, riot protection gear (batons/helmets/shields), breaching apparatus, night vision, robots, and small arms/personal weapons.

Controlled property always remains the property of and is accountable to the DoD. Please note this notice does not ensure acquisition of stated property, as all property is on a first come basis with all participating LEAs in 49 states and four U.S. territories. While the Fraser Winter Park Police Department does not intend to obtain most of this equipment, we have used this program in the past. We have also sought to obtain surplus ammunition for training purposes. Should a need arise to obtain additional equipment, we will make the proper notification to the as required under the Presidential Order.
