

Wolf Park – Picnic Pavilion Rules & Regulations

The Picnic Pavilion in Wolf Park is available to reserve during the months of May through October, weather dependent.

General Policies

- Hours Available: 8 a.m. 9 p.m., events are limited to a four-hour duration
- Groups are limited to four (4) parking spaces and no more than 50 persons
- Reservations are only accepted during the current year, starting each January
- Reservations are considered on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to historic or Town sponsored uses and Winter Park residents
- Recurring or consecutive reservation requests are prohibited
- Area must remain open to the general public at all times
- Applicant is responsible for cleanup and trash removal
- This space not to be used for conducting business for pecuniary gains

Rules

- Please be respectful of all the other park users around you. Poor behavior and language will not be tolerated.
- Wolf Park is a SMOKE-FREE facility. Please refrain from using all types of smoking products in the Park.
- All pets must be on a leash. Please pick up after your pet. Bags are provided for your convenience at various locations throughout the Park.
- Wolf Park is a passive park setting and wildlife may be present (specifically moose and bear). Please refrain from either feeding or harassing wildlife while in Wolf Park. Remember we are in their environment.
- Please clean up all trash and refuse after using the Park's facilities to ensure a pleasant experience for other users. Human trash can be extremely attractive and harmful to wildlife. Wildlife-proof trash enclosures are provided throughout the Park for your convenience.
