

TOWN COUNCIL FIVE-YEAR PLAN

ADOPTED JULY 18, 2023

In five years, Winter Park will ...

Have plans for the financing and constructing of the resort connections (gondola and bike/ski-back trail), moving toward approval and construction.

Have established a district (URA, DDA, PIF, etc.) for financing public infrastructure associated with development plans in key community locations.

Have advanced efforts for the formation of a regional transportation authority to participate in the funding of regional transit operations and connections.

Develop strategies/plans to leverage the private investment in Winter Park to finance the construction of downtown connections, walkability, and other desired amenities.

Have established an economic development committee of key stakeholders and investors to provide input and coordination of private investment.

Be advancing (or have completed) the acquisition of the Denver Water property at the end of Vasquez Road and other properties for trailheads, etc.

Implement the recommendations of the Parks, Open Space, Trails & Campgrounds plan adopted by the Town.

Continue the development of community housing throughout Winter Park and the Fraser River Valley Housing Partnership district.

Support funding critical community functions (childcare, mental health) and other sustainable community initiatives.

Be implementing sustainability initiatives (solar projects, electric vehicle deployment).

Have implemented fire mitigation projects on USFS and private lands adjacent to Winter Park and surrounding communities.

Advanced water management strategies to preserve critical flows within Winter Park's creeks and rivers.

Complete the construction of a police facility.

Have brought back more community engagement events that capture our local character and culture.
