MOST NOTABLE

LODGING FEE APPROVED

Voters approved a 2% increase in lodging taxes to fund community housing programs. Lodging tax increases will take effect July 1.

HIDEAWAY JUNCTION PHASE II CONSTRUCTION

By the end of 2023, construction was well underway, with several homes ready for move-in in early spring 2024.

OPEN SPACE, TRAILS, PARKS, AND CAMPGROUND MASTER PLAN

The Town started surveying the community about park amenities to begin developing our new Master Plan, received 215 survey responses, and met with over 100 individuals.

TRANSIT PLAN

The Lift began gathering public feedback for a Transit 5-Year Development Plan and received over 300 responses to its survey.

LAUNCHED E-BIKE REBATE PROGRAM

Town Council ramped up sustainability efforts with an approved \$10,000 to fund an e-bike rebate program.

TRANSIT MAINTENANCE FACILITY

The Town completed construction of the \$23M facility to advance transit goals.

BEAVER VILLAGE ANNEXATION

The Town has been securing easements for the gondola corridor to eventually connect Winter Park Resort with the Town via gondola. In 2023, the Town annexed Beaver Village Condominiums into Town limits.

FINANCE DEPT. / BUDGET

- ▶ \$39.6 M adopted total revenue in 2023
- ▶ Issued over **1,400** Short-Term Rental licenses

COMMUNITY GRANTS

 Received a \$1.1 million Low/No Emissions Bus Grant for electric bus and supporting infrastructure from the Federal Transit Administration

HOUSING INITIATIVES

AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECTS

- Fireside Creek Apartments: This public/ private partnership brought 50 new affordable housing units to the Town over the summer.
- ▶ By the end of 2023, **Hideaway Junction**Phase II construction was well underway, with several homes ready for move-in in early spring 2024.

■ ADOPTED 3-YEAR HOUSING PLAN

► Outlined housing strategies and projected units through 2025.

PROPOSITION 123

► The Town committed to expanding affordable housing inventory by 3% annually, or 9% over the next three years, to qualify for state funding through Proposition 123.



POLICE

- Responded to 6,091 calls
- ▶ **517** traffic citations
- Hosted 10 free Responsible Alcohol Server Trainings (RAST) for servers, bartenders, managers, event volunteers, etc. with 148 participants
- ▶ 1,175 code enforcement calls
- 223 Fraser Winter Park combined Municipal Court cases
- ▶ 2 new officers completed Colorado Law Enforcement Training Academies



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

BUILDING DIVISION

- ▶ **425** total building permits issued
- 3,577 building inspections performed
- ▶ \$838,851 building fees collected
- **\$73,628,867** valuation

PLANNING DIVISION

- ▶ 116 planning cases reviewed
 - **20** minor site plans
 - 12 major site plans
 - 2 preliminary plats
 - 2 final plats
- The Downtown Plan advanced to the stage of developing engineering plans, which will be finalized in 2024.
- Adopted the 2021 International Building Codes for Winter Park, Fraser, and Granby.

COMMUNITY EVENTS AND ENGAGEMENT

- ➤ The 2023 Community Clean-Up Week saw several community member volunteers. The Town plans to offer electronic recycling and dumpsters for the 2024 event.
- 4 Coffee with Council events including Leaves & Lattes, Cruise with Council, and Ski with Council.

TRANSIT (THE LIFT)

- ► Total Ridership: 434,526
 - **+17%** from 2022
- Grand opening for Transit Maintenance Facility
- Procured 7 buses
- Launched an updated app with improved bus tracking and real-time alerts
- Added two round trips to Granby (increasing Granby ridership by 236%) and two new stops in the Roam Neighborhood

PUBLIC WORKS

- Maintained 16 miles of trails
- Purchased hybrid vehicle for admin use and an electric truck for Public Works
- Leased a 800 MHZ radio fleet to improve interoperability with other municipalities and emergency services
- Added 2 miles of road and sidewalk plowing in Roam Phase I
- ▶ Purchased new sidewalk plow

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
