

## **Grand County Water & Sanitation District No. 1** **Mandatory Watering Restrictions**

Effective June 1, 2026

The Grand County Drought Preparedness Committee has designated Grand County as being in a Stage 3 – Exceptional Drought. Snowpack levels are at record lows, and the current forecast is for above average temperatures & below average precipitation.

To promote responsible management of limited water resources, at its regular meeting on April 15, 2026, the Board of Directors of Grand County Water & Sanitation District No. 1 declared a water shortage in the District. In keeping with this declaration, the District is implementing mandatory outdoor watering restrictions effective June 1, 2026. Under these watering restrictions, customers may water outdoor areas no more than 2 days per week and must follow a set schedule. Customers are encouraged to conserve water where possible

### Outdoor Watering Days:

Beginning June 1, District customers may only water outdoors 2 days per week and must follow a set schedule.

- Single family residential properties with addresses ending in even numbers may water on Sunday and Thursday.
- Single family residential structures with addresses ending in odd numbers may water on Saturday and Wednesday.
- All other properties (multi-family, HOA, commercial), Tuesday and Friday.

Public parks and communal irrigated areas are encouraged to reduce water usage by 20%.

### Water Times:

- Watering between 6:00pm and 10:00am.

Denver Water has declared a Stage 1 drought due to record-low snowpack in areas where they collect water & below-average levels in their reservoirs. The District is requiring these restrictions to support and encourage water conservation on the Front Range and in our District. The District reserves the right to impose further restrictions if needed.
