

Grand County Water & Sanitation District No. 1 **Mandatory Watering Restrictions**

Effective August 19, 2026

Exceptionally dry conditions, combined with above-average temperatures, have combined to create unprecedented drought conditions in Colorado in 2026. To promote responsible management of limited water resources, at its regular meeting on April 15, 2026, the Board of Directors of Grand County Water & Sanitation District No. 1 declared a water shortage in the District and implemented mandatory watering restrictions limited to two days per week.

In response to declining supplies in the Historic Users Pool in Green Mountain Reservoir, the Board of Directors of Grand County Water & Sanitation District No. 1 is further restricting outdoor watering effective August 19, 2026. Under these watering restrictions, customers may water outdoor areas no more than 1 day per week and must follow a set schedule. In addition, customers are further encouraged to voluntarily conserve water where possible.

Outdoor Watering Days:

Beginning August 19, 2026, District customers may only water outdoors 1 day per week and must follow a set schedule.

- Single family residential properties with addresses ending in even numbers may water on Sunday.
- Single family residential structures with addresses ending in odd numbers may water on Saturday.
- All other properties (multi-family, HOA, commercial) may water on Tuesday.

Public parks and communal irrigated areas are encouraged to reduce water usage by 20%.

Water Times:

- Watering between 6:00pm and 10:00am.
